



Pettijohn Springs Christian Camp 2010 Summer Camp Application and Information

As we get ready for the 39th year of Pettijohn Springs Christian Camp (PSCC), the Board of Directors and Staff want to let you know how blessed we feel that you are planning to send your child to camp this year. Our prayer is that your camper will have a wonderful experience here. "A Camp Planned for You" is our goal.

This is your 2010 Pettijohn Springs Summer Camp information and application. The application form is different this year, so please read it carefully and fill in all the information—**front and back**. Incomplete information will result in a delay in your application being accepted. Please note that the camper fee has increased to \$140 (\$70 for Beginner week) and the deposit has increased to \$40. This deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable after May 15, 2010.

Some sessions fill up quickly. Therefore, applications received with deposits will receive priority over applications received without deposits. If you need to make special arrangements regarding your deposit or camper fee, please feel free to contact the camp office.

Another change this year is the option to pay with your Visa or MasterCard credit card. However, there will be a \$6 transaction fee for each camper application that is paid by credit card.

Due to recent concerns about the H1N1 virus and other illnesses we would like to ask each family to consider the following. **KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME WHEN:**

- Child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher
- Child has diarrhea or vomiting
- Child has a rash of unknown origin
- Child has red, runny eyes or wakes up with eyes 'glued' shut
- Child complains of ear pain with or without fever

YOU MAY BRING YOUR CHILD TO CAMP WHEN:

- Child is fever free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or other fever reducer
- Child is free of diarrhea or vomiting for 24 hours
- You have consulted a health care professional and receive a clear bill of health or the appropriate antibiotic therapy

Pettijohn Springs Christian Camp works in conjunction with the Oklahoma State Department of Health to maintain a clean and safe environment. There are times when issues arise that are outside our control. We ask for your patience and understanding when occurrences such as lice or stomach viruses spread throughout a camp session. We will always strive to protect the health, safety and emotional well-being of **all** our campers.
